4. Being witnesses for Christ can feel scary or intimidating. Yet, here Jesus says that God's Holy Spirit indwells each one of us, and empowers us for the very task of sharing Him with others. What are some triggers or ways in which you can strive to be more open and sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading, and the opportunities He provides?

5. Identify some of the people God has placed in the concentric circles of your life – Jerusalem (those closest to you), Judea & Samaria (people you are acquainted with), and the ends of the earth. How can you remember to pray for those people and seek opportunities to work Christ into conversations?

6. What holds you back from spreading the word about Jesus?
