4. Joshua argues that God should be our priority. Is it ever appropriate for another aspect of your life to temporarily take precedence over your relationship with God? Why or why not?

5. What sorts of things can distract us from giving God our full focus in all areas of our lives?

 Joshua took a stand and made his decision to serve the Lord, regardless of what anyone else would decide. Describe a time when you had to take a stand no matter what anyone else around you was doing.

Reflect on Joshua's statement, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Take time to prayerfully evaluate whether or not you can share in his statement. If not, how can you reaffirm your love for the Lord and remain committed to serving Him?
