4. What do you see Jesus trying to teach His disciples in v.8?

5. Mary gave lavishly for Jesus; Judas wanted to see what he could get from Jesus. In what ways can we be like Mary, and Judas, in our relationship with the Lord?

6. God may or may not ever call us to do something as extravagant as Mary did. How can we prepare ourselves now to be willing to answer the call, should God ever give it?
