2. Three verses in our passage (1, 3, 11) speak of Jesus' knowledge about what was coming. John also says that God "knows everything" (1 Jn. 3:20). What do the following passages teach us about the knowledge of God? See: Psa. 139:1-16; Isa. 42:8-9; Matt. 10:29-31.

3. As Jesus washed the disciples' feet, He said that they would later come to understand the significance of what He was doing (v.7). Read Psa. 51:1-13. What do these verses contribute to our understanding of Jesus' actions with His disciples?

4. What is the essence of Jesus' charge in verses 12-17? How is this related to what John said in the second half of verse 1?

5. Based on your knowledge of God's Word, what does the future hold for those who follow Christ? How does this make you feel?

6. How would you feel if Jesus suddenly showed up at your house and began cleaning up your room or the garage? Why would you feel this way?
