My Story

1. Can you recall a time in your life when you were overwhelmed by God's creation? In what ways is the creation of a child similar or different?

Digging Deeper

2. Read Psalm 8:1-9. How do these verses show us the value God places on humankind?

3. What does David mean in Psalm 139:14, when says that we are "Fearfully" made? He also says that we are "Wonderfully" made. How do we reconcile that with the fact that people are sometimes born with various birth defects and disabilities?

4. Read Genesis 1:26-27. What does it mean that we are created in the image/likeness of God? How does this relate to the sanctity of human life?

Reflection

5. What kinds of things in our culture hinder us from valuing all people equally? What sorts of things encourage us to value some people more than others? How can we overcome this?

6. How can better understanding the value God places on us change our view of ourselves?
