4. The blind men call Jesus the "Son of David" (a Messianic title). In what ways are King David and Jesus similar, and in what ways are they different?

5. The crowd tried to keep the blind men from speaking to Jesus. In what sorts of ways do people or situations today try to keep us from Jesus?

6. If Jesus said to you today, "What do you want Me to do for you?" how would you answer?
