#### **My Story**

### **Digging Deeper**

2. Compare Psalm 19:1-4 to Romans 1:18-23. How does creation reveal God to humanity, and what can we learn about God from creation? Is this enough to leave people "without excuse" (Rom. 1:20)? Why/why not?

3. In Psalm 19:7-9, David describes the Law and its effect on our lives. Are these effects automatic? Why/why not? What are some specific ways you have been changed through reading God's Word?

4. David closes the psalm praying for God's deliverance from sin and that his actions might be acceptable to God. Read Ephesians 4:29, 5:4, and Philippians 4:8. According to these verses, which words and thoughts are pleasing to God and which are not?

#### Reflection

5. What are some ways we can take time to celebrate God's glory in creation?

6. What encourages you in your faith most: meditating on God's creation, meditating on God's Word, a combination of the two, or something else?
