### **My Story**

2. In verses 121-122 our author prays for God's provision. What other passages of Scripture show us God providing for people's needs? What do those passages teach us about our Heavenly Father?

3. Is there a difference between knowledge (teaching) & understanding (vv.124-125)? How would you differentiate them? What do James 1:5-8 + 3:17 contribute to your perception?

4. The psalmist believes in <u>all</u> God's precepts concerning <u>all</u> things (v.128). Which of the Lord's commandments/precepts do non-Christians seem to have the hardest time accepting?

#### Reflection

5. What types of situations really test your patience? What affects your ability to be patient (positively or negatively)?

6. Where are you waiting for the Lord's answer to your prayers right now? How can your group help you and pray for you?
