3. God knows everything about everything, including you and your life. Read Dan. 2:20-22 & Psa. 139:1-6. What do these passages tell us about God's knowledge & wisdom? How might this be an encouragement when sudden difficulties arise in life?

4. Why do you think Paul put this Doxology of praise here at the end of chapters 1-11, instead of at the end of Romans? What other passages of praise do you find in Scripture?

5. Where/When do you find yourself most inclined to worship God? What is it about that place/time that is so inspiring?
6. What are 3 specific reasons you can praise God today? What makes God worthy of your praise in each of these areas?
