Digging Deeper

2. Read verse 22 and then look back over the previous few verses (see also Rom. 1:13). What had hindered Paul from going to Rome? How had his situation changed?

3. Compare verse 24 with what Paul said in Rom. 1:11-12. What sort of encouragement and help do you think Paul expected to receive from the Roman Christians? What might he have had to offer them?

4. Paul lists 3 different locations he hopes to visit in his ministry plans. Was it right for him to declare these plans? How does James 4:13-15 influence your answer?

5. What are some ways churches can encourage and minister to missionaries? What are some ways we can be ministered to by missionaries?

6. Paul had a clear plan for his ministry and for reaching the lost. Do you? What would help you feel more prepared to share your faith with others?
