5. How can we know if our standard of living is self-indulgent or not? Are you generous with the resources God has given you? In what areas would you like to grow in generosity?

3. Jesus also spoke about wealth. Read Matt. 6:19-21. Give some examples of earthly and heavenly treasures. How do people store each of these up?

6. Do you tend to feel more secure when you have more money? Less secure when you have less money? How can we center our hearts on God rather than wealth?
