4. What is the relationship between divine preparation and human initiative in this account?

#### Reflection

5. God gifts all of His children uniquely. Not everyone is called to be a preacher or a street-corner evangelist. But, we are all commissioned to be ready to share the reason we believe the Gospel. How ready do you feel? Would you be able to explain the basics of faith in Christ if someone asked you?

6. God's Spirit led Philip to speak to the eunuch. Are you looking for and willing to respond to God's guidance in your life? How can we discern the Spirit's leading?

Take time this week to write out a condensed version of your personal testimony. Use these 3 points to help you format it: 1) What my life was like before Christ; 2) How I came to believe in Christ; 3) What my life has been like since believing in Christ.
