### My Story

### Digging Deeper

2. Paul is addressing these words to those, “who want to be under the law” (v.21). In what ways do Christians want to be under the law at times?
3. How do the two births in this passage represent two approaches to being in a relationship with God? How does this relate to what was happening in the Galatian churches?

4. The Judiazers considered themselves the children of Sarah and viewed Gentiles as the children of Hagar. Why does Paul reverse this? How does this reinforce his point in Gal. 3:7 and 4:6-9?

5. Paul calls us children of promise, how should that change the way we live our lives?
6. Why do you think it is sometimes easier to fall back into legalism or performance-based faith rather than trusting in God’s promise?
