4. Read 1 Cor. 15:1-19. How does this help us understand the importance of Jesus' resurrection to the Christian faith?

5. What do you find to be the strongest evidence for Christ's resurrection? What further evidence do you imagine would convince non-Christians to believe in Christ? Why?

6. When did the reality of Christ's crucifixion begin to make a difference in your own life?
