4. Why does Paul describe the Gospel as something that prepares believers rather than merely informs them? How does the Gospel prepare believers to endure hardship or suffering?

5. Why is it difficult at times to remain grounded in peace when circumstances are unsettled? How can you better prepare yourself to respond faithfully when conflict or opposition arises?
6. What are some things you can do to “put on” Gospel readiness in your daily routines and decisions? How does remembering what Christ has done bring stability and direction to your spiritual walk?
